
Post-Traumatic Epilepsy Clinic

Not everyone with a traumatic brain injury (TBI) will have a seizure or develop epilepsy, known as post-traumatic epilepsy, but those who do often struggle to find the right balance between getting their seizures under control and minimizing the side effects of their medication. This is because the very injury that caused your seizures can also make your brain more susceptible to side effects of anti-seizure medications.
