Barrow Neurological Institute is seeking one American board-eligible or board-certified (BE/BC) neurosurgeon at any point in their career to engage in a one-year fully funded fellowship in global health neurosurgery as part of the Franke Global Neuroscience Education Center and Barrow Global. This position is for the Academic Year July 2027 through June 2028.

This, a major initiative of Barrow to promote excellence in neurosurgical care in the developing world, will entail spending up to nine months in Northern Tanzania where the Franke Fellow and Barrow Global faculty will be engaged in developing a neurosurgical center of excellence for training and clinical care in partnership with regional neurosurgeons.

Three months of the year will be spent at Barrow in Phoenix, Arizona, obtaining training in global health management, enhancing clinical skills desired via the Institute's renowned faculty, and mentoring residents and students in global health neurosurgery research. Cultural, language, and educational training in how to teach in the developing world will be provided prior to, and during deployment, overseas.

A qualified candidate for this fellowship is passionate about global health care and wishes to pursue a career as a leader in neurosurgery. This program is designed to provide a firm academic and experiential foundation for this endeavor. This position includes salary, benefits as well as travel and housing costs.
