

Barrow Emergency Stroke Treatment Unit



The Barrow Emergency Stroke Treatment Unit is a specially equipped and staffed mobile emergency room that brings expert stroke care directly to patients, revolutionizing the way many stroke victims in Phoenix receive treatment. The mobile stroke unit contains a portable lab and CT Scanner, clot-dissolving drugs, and a trained stroke team. The team connects with a Barrow vascular neurologist via telemedicine.

Barrow launched the unit in partnership with the Phoenix Fire Department, whose 911 dispatchers deploy the unit whenever they receive a call about a possible stroke within the unit's response radius. The collaboration is helping to speed the process in which strokes are diagnosed and treated, with the goal of reducing death and long-term disability among stroke victims.
