Barrow Neuro-Rehabilitative Services offers unparalleled rehabilitative care for individuals after surviving a stroke. The primary goal of Barrow Neuro-Rehabilitation Specialists is to help patients enhance their quality of life through improved skills, maximized independence, and renewed self-esteem. Specific criteria are identified and must be met to qualify a patient for admission.

Intensity of Services / Participation Requirements

- Therapy services provided five to seven days a week
- Average of three hours of therapy per day, Monday through Friday with additional therapy on Saturday and Sunday
- Medical stability/absence of medical problems that would interfere with participation in therapies.
- Must be able to demonstrate progress towards meeting established team discharge goals.

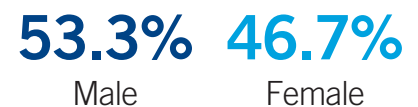
This program does not currently serve persons who are:

Number of Patients Served

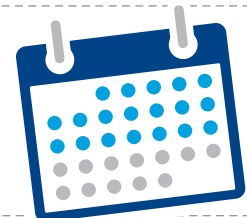
