Stroke is a leading cause of death and disability for Americans, but it is estimated that up to 90 percent of strokes may be prevented with medical management of risk factors. Knowing which risk factors to control can be challenging. Barrow Neurological Institute's Petznick Stroke Center offers a multidisciplinary Stroke Prevention Clinic to help patients and their primary care providers manage these risk factors:

- High Blood Pressure
- High Cholesterol
- Diabetes
- Smoking
- Obstructive Sleep Apnea

- Family History of Stroke
- Genetic Predisposition to Blood Clots
- Atrial Fibrillation
- Patent Foramen Ovale (PFO)
- Other Cardiovascular Abnormalities

Each patient will receive an in-depth assessment, educational materials, and access to additional support and resources for managing their stroke risk. We specialize in the primary and secondary prevention of ischemic and hemorrhagic strokes. We also see patients with:

- Transient Ischemic Attack (TIA)
- Silent Strokes/Infarcts
- Large Artery Atherosclerosis
- Vascular/Ischemic White Matter Disease
- Cerebral Microbleeds Microhemorrhages

We collaborate with colleagues in vascular and endovascular neurosurgery, neuro-rehabilitation, neuro-radiology, endocrinology and cardiology. We are using implantable cardiac monitors and transcranial doppler (TCD) studies to detect atrial fibrillation and PFO.

Barrow Neurological Institute offers comprehensive care for individuals with stroke—from the pre-hospital setting to acute care, neuro-rehabilitation, and reintegration into the community. Our Petznick Stroke Center cares for more stroke victims and conducts more prevention research trials than any other center in the Southwest.
