

Feature: Voice Control

Description: Ability to control phone/tablet with voice commands.

Applicable Areas: Loss of upper extremity function

Set-up & Details:

Apple/iOS:

- Navigate to settings
- Accessibility
- Voice Control
 - If never used, Set Up Voice Control
- Toggle Voice Control on

To review voice commands, go to Commands.

You are able to create individual commands/short cuts for commonly used features/phrases.

Continuous Overlay: this allows labels (i.e., numbers, names, grid) to appear for easier commands

Android:

- Navigate to Settings
- Accessibility
- Voice Access
- Toggle Voice Access on

Note: On some Android devices, this may require downloading the separate Voice Access application from the Google Play Store before it appears in the menu.

Pro tips:

- If vocal volume is a challenge or the patient would like to be more discreet, they may use one or two earbuds with microphone capabilities.
